T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"), through the undersigned counsel, updates the ownership information set forth in its August 26, 2009 petition for a declaratory ruling under Section 310(b)(4) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to allow up to 100 percent indirect foreign ownership in WALLC License, LLC ("WALLC License Sub"). Specifically, a wholly-owned intermediate-tier holding company – T-Mobile Global Zwischenholding GmbH ("TGZ") – was inadvertently excluded from the description of T-Mobile's current, and WALLC License Sub's proposed, corporate ownership structure. TGZ, which holds 100 percent of the ownership interests of T-Mobile Global Holding GmbH, is a wholly-owned direct subsidiary of Deutsche Telekom AG (T-Mobile's ultimate parent company). A revised Exhibit A depicting the post-consummation ownership structure of T-Mobile and WALLC License Sub is attached.
