Section 310(b) Petition for Declaratory Ruling**

Request for Withdrawal of Petition for Declaratory Ruling

PetroCom License Corporation (“PetroCom”) filed a Section 310(b) Petition for Declaratory Ruling^{1/} (“Petition”) on March 26, 2010 seeking to extend PetroCom’s existing authority to proposed operations in the 3.65 GHz band. The Petition appeared as accepted for public filing on April 21, 2010.^{2/}
