Dear Mr. LaFuria:

On behalf of the Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), and the Department of Justice (“DOJ”), including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, (collectively, the “Agencies”) I am writing in regard to the obligations undertaken by Telemetrix Inc. (“Telemetrix”) in a Letter of Assurance (“LOA”) dated July 24, 2006, which was executed in connection with the Agencies review of a Petition filed by Telemetrix with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”).<sup>1</sup>

The Agencies have learned that the ownership structure of Telemetrix has changed as a result of several transactions subsequent to the 2006 LOA. As a result of these transactions, the Agencies understand that Telemetrix was initially sold to Green Eagle Communications, Inc. (Green Eagle) as part of foreclosure proceedings.<sup>2</sup> The Agencies also understand, based on information provided by Telemetrix that in July 2015, NE Colorado Cellular Inc. d/b/a Viaero Wireless (“Viaero”), a U.S. company, acquired the FCC PCS licenses under the control of Green Eagle (and formerly Telemetrix)<sup>3</sup>.

In light of these developments, the Agencies hereby terminate the July 24, 2006 LOA and release Telemetrix, Viaero and any other relevant entities from the obligations contained in such LOA.
