

safety concerns are part of its public interest analysis, and has accorded deference to the views of other U.S. government agencies with expertise in those areas.⁴

Accordingly, DOJ advises the Commission that it has no objection to the Commission granting the application in the above-referenced proceedings, provided that the Commission conditions its consent on the compliance by Onvoy with the Agreement.
