The Department of Justice (“DOJ”), with the concurrence of the Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”) and the Department of Defense (“DOD”) (collectively, the “Agencies”), requests that the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) defer action on the above-referenced proceedings. The Agencies are currently reviewing these matters for any national security, law enforcement, and public safety issues but have not yet completed that effort.
