## Re: Response Required – Potential Dismissal of Petition for Declaratory Ruling Filed by C494C17Y Co. File No. ISP-PDR-20200922-00009

Dear Ms. Prudham:

On September 22, 2020, C494C17Y Co. (C494C17Y) filed the above referenced petition with the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) to enable its participation in FCC Auction 107.<sup>1</sup> C494C17Y was not the winning bidder of Auction 107.<sup>2</sup>

On June 7, 2021, the International Bureau notified you that since C494C17Y was not the winning bidder, you would need to withdraw the petition for declaratory ruling<sup>3</sup>. On July 7, 2021, the Commission again notified you that you need to withdraw the petition for declaratory ruling<sup>4</sup> or we would begin dismissal procedures.

If you do not withdraw the above-mentioned petition by **October 29, 2021**, we provide notice that the above referenced petition will be dismissed without prejudice under section 1.748(a) of the Commission's rules.<sup>5</sup> Should you need assistance withdrawing your application, please contact me at 202-418-0574.
