ORDER, AUTHORIZATION AND CERTIFICATE

Adopted: January 12, 1988; Released: January 25, 1988

****333** By the Acting Chief, International Facilities Division:

1. The instant uncontested application, filed on October 28, 1987 by Allnet Communications Services, Inc. (Allnet), requests authority to lease and operate satellite and connecting facilities for direct service to Hong Kong. Upon consideration of the application, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the present and future public convenience and necessity require the provision of direct service to Hong Kong by Allnet.

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that application File No. **I-T-C-88-013** IS GRANTED, and Allnet is authorized to:

a. lease from Comsat and operate 24 voice-grade satellite circuits between an appropriate earth station on the west coast of the United States mainland and an appropriate satellite over the Pacific Ocean, connecting with similar circuits between the satellite and an earth station in Hong Kong, furnished by Allnet's correspondent in Hong Kong;

b. lease and operate 24 voice-grade circuits between the west coast earth station and Allnet's Salinas, California operating office;

c. acquire and operate necessary terminal equipment including multiplex; and

d. use said facilities to provide Allnet's regularly authorized services between the U.S. and Hong Kong and beyond.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction over this matter to reallocate circuits in the satellite system among the various international common carriers and other authorized users as required to insure nondiscriminatory use of, and equitable access to, the communications satellite system.

4. No material changes inconsistent with this or any other relevant Commission order shall be made before final execution of an operating agreement between All-

net and its correspondent in Hong Kong, and a copy of the agreement shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days of its execution.

5. This authorization is effective on its release date and shall be continued year-to-year, unless the Commission notifies the applicant to the contrary and requires a new application to be filed. If the Commission requires a new application to be filed, the authorization will continue in effect until Commission action on the application.

6. This order is issued under Section 0.291 of the Commission's rules and is effective upon release. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106 or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the rules may be filed within 30 days of the date of public notice of this order (see Section 1.4(b)(2)).
