Re: *Qwest Communications International Inc. Surrender of Subsidiaries'
International Section 214 Authorizations*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest"), by counsel and on behalf of its wholly-owned subsidiaries, hereby surrenders the international Section 214 authorizations listed in the Attachment hereto.

Qwest's subsidiaries have undergone a number of internal corporate reorganizations and changes in business plans in recent years. As a result, Qwest's subsidiaries now hold a number of authorizations that are either duplicative of their existing global facilities-based and global resale authorizations, or are not needed as the subsidiary in question no longer offers international telecommunications services. To reduce the administrative burden associated with maintaining its Commission authorizations, these subsidiaries are surrendering the international Section 214 authorizations listed in the Attachment.

Qwest Communications Company, LLC ("QCC") holds the vast majority of the authorizations to be surrendered, many of which were obtained by QCC's predecessors-in-interest long before the Commission authorized carriers to obtain global facilities-based and global resale services. QCC will retain a number of international Section 214 authorizations covering the same international telecommunications services covered by the authorizations


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surrendered herein.¹ At no time will QCC provide international telecommunications services without Commission authority. QCC will continue to provide the same services before and after it surrenders these certificates, so this action will have no effect on the company's operations or its subscribers. QCC is also retaining its cable landing license, File No. SCL-LIC-19981117-00025, so the provisions of Section 1.767(m)(2) of the rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(m)(2), are not at issue here.
