ORDER, AUTHORIZATION AND CERTIFICATE

Adopted: March 12, 1992;

Released: March 20, 1992

By the Chief, International Facilities Division:

1. Upon consideration of the above-captioned uncontested applications, filed pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, IT IS

HEREBY CERTIFIED that the present and future public convenience and necessity require the provision of international switched voice service to the general public by US Communications of Illinois, Inc. (USCI), National Telecommunications Consultants, Inc. (NTC), Arbud Telecommunications, Inc. (Arbud), Telepacific Communications Corp. (Telepacific), Public Switch Corp., CC/USA International Ltd. (CC/USA) and Tel-Save, Inc.

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that applications File Nos. I-T-C-92-048, I-T-C-92-049, I-T-C-92-052, I-T-C-92-056, I-T-C-92-057, I-T-C-92-060 and I-T-C-92-061 ARE GRANTED, and

a. USCI and NTC are authorized to provide international switched voice, facsimile and data service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, US Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Intellicall Operator Services, Inc.'s Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, International Telecharge's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, and WTG's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the US and the points listed in those tariffs;

b. Arbud is authorized to provide international switched voice service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in Intellicall Operator Services, Inc.'s Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the US and the points listed in that tariff;

c. Telepacific is authorized to provide international switched voice service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, US Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, West Coast's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and ANT's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and the points listed in those tariffs;

d. Public Switch is authorized to provide international switched voice service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and US Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the US and the points listed in those tariffs;

e. CC/USA is authorized to provide international switched voice service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, and US Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and the points listed in those tariffs; and

f. Tel-Save is authorized to provide international switched voice service by the resale of the international switched voice service set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the U.S. and the points listed in that tariffs.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall obtain any necessary operating agreements in each of the countries to which they will provide service and shall file them with the Commission within 30 days of their execution.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall file tariffs pursuant to Section 203 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 203, and Part 61 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Part 61, for the services authorized in this Order.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall file the annual reports of overseas telecommunications traffic required by Section 43.61 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §43.61.

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing in this authorization should be construed to include authorization for the transmission of money in connection with the services the applicants seek authority to provide. The transmission of money is not considered to be a common carrier service. Therefore, nothing in this Order should be construed as containing authority for the transmission of money.

7. This order is issued under Section 0.291 of the Commission's Rules and is effective upon adoption. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106 or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the Commission's Rules may be filed within 30 days of public notice of this order (*see* Section 1.4(b)(2)).
