Pursuant to § 55-11-10(d) and § 57C-9A-22 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, Lexcom LD Acquisition Company, LLC (the "surviving entity"), a limited liability company organized under the law of North Carolina, whose address is 200 North State Street, Lexington, North Carolina 27293, hereby submits these Articles of Merger for the purpose of merging Lexcom Long Distance, Inc. (the "merging entity"), a corporation organized the law of North Carolina, into the surviving entity, whose name will change to "Lexcom Long Distance, LLC":

- I. The Plan of Merger that was duly approved in the manner prescribed by law by each of the entities participating in the merger is attached as Exhibit A.
