ORDER, AUTHORIZATION AND CERTIFICATE

Adopted: May 12, 1993;

Released: May 25, 1993

By the Chief, International Facilities Division:

1. Upon consideration of the above-captioned uncontested applications, filed pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the present and future public convenience and necessity require the provision of international switched services to the general public on a resale basis by St. Thomas & San Juan Telephone Co.

(STSI), Keystone Telecommunications, Inc. (Keystone), International Quarter Phones, Inc. (IOPI), Londono RTS Inc. (Londono), Communications Buyers Group, Inc. (CBG), Mountaineer Long Distance, Inc. (Mountaineer), Princeton Telecommunications Corp. (Princeton), LinkUSA Corp. (LinkUSA), National Communications Association, Inc. (NCA), Teledial America of North Carolina, Inc. (Teledial of NC), North America Telephone - TPA, Inc. (TPA), American Communications International, Ltd. (ACI), Cellular Long Distance Service Corp. (CLDS), Hospitality Communications Corp. d/b/a HCC Telemanagement (HCC), ALD Communications, Inc. (ALD), Hertz Technologies, Inc. (Hertz), Group Long Distance (USA) Inc. (GLD), GTI Telecom, Inc. (GTI), U.S. Satellite Telecommunications (USST), WorldTel Services, Inc. (WorldTel), Lexington Telephone Long Distance Co., Inc. (LTLD), TeleData International, Inc. (TDD), Communications Gateway Network, Inc. (CGN) and Preferred Network (PN).

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that applications File Nos. I-T-C-93-036, I-T-C-93-070, I-T-C-93-078, I-T-C-93-092, I-T-C-93-094, I-T-C-93-095, I-T-C-93-096, I-T-C-93-098, I-T-C-93-099, I-T-C-93-101, I-T-C-93-103, I-T-C-93-105, I-T-C-93-108, I-T-C-93-110, I-T-C-93-111, I-T-C-93-112, I-T-C-93-113, I-T-C-93-114, I-T-C-93-115, I-T-C-93-118, I-T-C-93-120, I-T-C-93-121, I-T-C-93-122 and I-T-C-93-125 ARE GRANTED; and

a. STSI is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in ATC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Worldcom's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, TRT/FTC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 15, Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, RCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, WillTel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 and Fonorola's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

b. Keystone is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, RCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and WillTel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

c. IOPI is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and ATC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

d. Londono, LTLD and PN are authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

e. CBG is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, WillTel's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

f. Mountaineer is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in RCI's Tariff No. 1 between the U.S. and Canada;

g. Princeton is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1, 2 and 12, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Wiltel's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Litel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, C&W's Tariff F.C.C. No. 3 and West Coast Telecommunications' Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

h. LinkUSA is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Allnet's Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Advanced Telecommunications' Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, C&W's Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, COM Systems' Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, LDDDS' Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Metromedia Communications' and MDL Long Distance's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, RCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Schneider Communications' Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Southern Pacific Telecom's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, WUI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 28 and Wiltel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

i. NCA is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. No. 1 and TRT/FTC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 15 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

j. Teledial of NC is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Wiltel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

k. Hertz and CGN are authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Wiltel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

l. HCC, TPA and GTI are authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, C&W's Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, Wiltel's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Metromedia's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Litel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, and Advanced Telecommunications' Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

m. ACI is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Allnet's Tariff F.C.C. No. 5, Metromedia Communications' Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, LDDDS'

Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Rochester Telecommunications Services' Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, Wiltel's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

n. CLDS is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. No. 1 and ACC Long Distance's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

o. ALD is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 12 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

p. GLD is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. No. 1 and Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs;

q. USST is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in that tariff;

r. WorldTel is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Wiltel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs; and

s. TDI is authorized to provide international switched services by the resale of the international switched voice services set forth in AT&T's Tariffs F.C.C. No. 1 and 2, MCI's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Sprint's Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 2, C&W's Tariff F.C.C. No. 3, Wiltel's Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 and ATC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 between the U.S. and international points listed in those tariffs.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall obtain any necessary operating agreements in each of the countries to which they will provide service and shall file them with the Commission within 30 days of their execution.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall file tariffs pursuant to Section 203 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 203, and Part 61 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Part 61, for the services authorized in this Order.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicants shall file the annual reports of overseas telecommunications traffic required by Section 43.61 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §43.61.

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing in this authorization should be construed to include authorization for the transmission of money in connection with the services the applicants seek authority to provide. The transmission of money is not considered to be a common

carrier service. Therefore, nothing in this Order should be construed as containing authority for the transmission of money.

7. This order is issued under Section 0.291 of the Commission's Rules and is effective upon adoption. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106 or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the Commission's Rules may be filed within 30 days of the notice of this order (see Section 1.4(b)(2)).
