Surrender Of International Section 214 Authority On U.S.-Montenegro Route

Dear Ms. Dortch:

T-Mobile USA, Inc. and its wholly-owned subsidiaries (collectively, "T-Mobile") hereby surrender their authority to provide international telecommunications service between the United States and Montenegro under the above-referenced international Section 214 authorization. T-Mobile, however, will continue to serve other approved U.S.-international routes under the above-referenced Section 214 authorization.

As further discussed in the concurrently filed foreign carrier affiliate notification, T-Mobile has acquired a new foreign carrier affiliation with Telekom Crne Gore A.D., the monopoly fixed line telecommunications carrier in Montenegro. Montenegro is an observer, rather than a member, of the World Trade Organization. Accordingly, T-Mobile is relinquishing its existing authority to serve the U.S.-Montenegro route effective immediately. T-Mobile reserves its right to petition the Commission at a later date for authority to serve the U.S.-Montenegro route.
