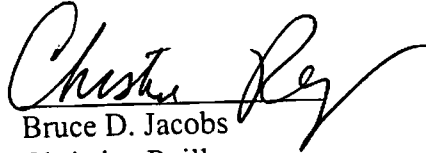

Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC ("MSV") hereby requests a correction of the Commission's IBFS database to remove FCC File No. ITC-214-19961118-00577 from the IBFS "International Section 214 Current Authorizations List." On November 18, 1996, AMSC Subsidiary Corporation ("AMSC"), MSV's predecessor in interest, filed an application for Section 214 authority (the "Application"). *See* FCC File No. ITC-214-19961118-00577 (formerly ITC-96-633). On January 31, 1997, prior to the grant of the Application, AMSC filed a letter requesting dismissal ("Dismissal Request") of the Application. *See* attached Letter to William Caton, Acting Secretary of the FCC, from Robert Galbreath, Counsel for AMSC Subsidiary Corporation (January 31, 1997). On February 4, 1997, the Commission issued a letter granting dismissal of the Application. *See* attached Letter to Robert L. Galbreath, from Diane J. 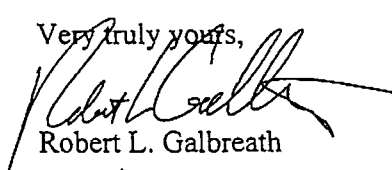
