Pursuant to Section 63.21 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 63.21, SBC Communications Inc. on behalf of its subsidiaries, Southwestern Bell Communications Services Inc., SBC Global Communications, Inc., SNET America, Inc. and SNET Diversified Group, Inc., collectively referred to herein as SBC, by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Commission that as a result of recent public offering by Belgacom S.A. (Belgacom), SBC no longer holds an ownership interest in and is therefore no longer affiliated with Belgacom and its foreign carrier subsidiaries and affiliates. SBC is no longer affiliated with the foreign carriers listed below:



Because SBC is no longer affiliated with Belgacom, SBC is now eligible for non-dominant treatment on the U.S.-Belgium route as it is neither a foreign carrier nor affiliated with a foreign carrier in Belgium. See 47 C.F.R. § 63.10(a)(1). SBC will shortly file a request for non-dominant regulatory treatment on the U.S.-Belgium route. In the interim, however, SBC will continue to accept dominant carrier regulation on the U.S.-Belgium route until such time as the Commission confirms SBC's non-dominant regulatory status on that route pursuant to Section 63.13 of the rules.
