Dear Sir or Madam:

This firm represents Local Long Distance, L.C. ("LLD"). The FCC granted LLD international Section 214 authority to provide global resale service on April 11, 1997, file number ITC-214-19970207-00071. Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 63.19(a)(1), LLD is providing notice to the FCC that effective August 1, 2009, LLD will discontinue providing international long distance service in the Terril local wireline exchange area and the Royal local wireline exchange area, each in the State of Iowa. LLD will continue to provide international services in other service areas in the State of Iowa. LLD notified affected customers by letter sent via U.S. Mail on June 24, 2009. Important Notice: Your Long Distance Telephone Service Is Being Discontinued

Dear Valued Customer:

As of August 1, 2009, the Local Long Distance/Local Alliance Network long distance telephone service you are subscribed to will no longer be available in your service area. The geographic areas impacted by this discontinuance of service include the Royal and Terril local exchange service areas in the state of Iowa. The services affected included domestic and international long distance service. In order to assure continued service, we encourage you to select another long distance service provider as soon as possible. You have the right to select any company that is offering long distance telephone service in your area. A list of alternate service providers may be found in your local telephone directory.

As a carrier discontinuing service, Local Long Distance, L.C. must file a request to discontinue service with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. Address any comments to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of Local Long Distance, L.C. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
