On behalf of Local Fiber, LLC (“Local Fiber”), this letter surrenders, effective immediately, the International Section 214 Authorization of Local Fiber, LLC granted in IB File No. ITC-214-19970327-00177 (Old File No. ITC-97-200) (the “International 214 Authority”).

Local Fiber no longer provide telecommunications services and, therefore, no longer requires the International 214 Authority. Because Local Fiber does not currently provide any international telecommunications services, Local Fiber respectfully submits that the surrender of the International 214 Authority is reasonable and necessary and will not be disruptive to the present or future public interest, convenience and necessity.
