Re: Surrender of International Section 214 Authorization

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of AT&T Mobility of Puerto Rico Inc. ("AMPR"), I hereby notify the Commission that AMPR is surrendering the following international Section 214 authorization: **File No. ITC-214-19980430-00923**. This authorization permits AMPR to acquire and operate capacity in the Americas-II submarine cable system. Contemporaneously, AMPR also is filing an application to modify the Americas-II submarine cable landing license, File No. SCL-LIC-19980429-00019, to relinquish AMPR's interest in that license. As is explained in more detail in that application, AMPR has conveyed its rights and obligations under the Americas-II Cable System Construction and Maintenance Agreement ("C&MA") to AT&T Corp., which, like AMPR, is a wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Inc. AT&T Corp. already has an international Section 214 authorization to construct, acquire, and operate capacity in Americas-II. *See* File No. ITC-214-19980430-00286 (Old File No. ITC-98-342).
