APPLICATION FOR INTERNATIONAL
RESALE AUTHORIZATION

Commsource International, LLC ("CSI"), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and Section 63.01 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.C. Section 63.01, hereby applies for authorization to resell the International Telecommunications Services of other common carriers for the purpose of providing telecommunications services for and from the United States to and from all countries throughout the world.

CSI is a domestic corporation no part of which is directly or indirectly controlled by foreign telecommunications entities. It plans to utilize or lease for resale international facilities of authorized facilities-based carriers to provide services. CSI submits that its subject application will serve the public interest by advancing competition in the provision of services to and from foreign markets.

Pursuant to Section 63.01 of the Commission's Rules, the following specific information is submitted in support of this application:

(a) The name of the applicant is Commsource International, LLC. Its place of business is 700 South Flower Street, Suite 420, Los Angeles, California 90017.

(b) The applicant is a corporation organized and existing in good standing under the laws of the State of California.

(d) Approval of this application will authorize CSI for the first time to operate as a common carrier pursuant to the Act.

(e) The applicant will obtain and resell the services of other carriers that may be authorized by the Commission to service the designated foreign territories.

(f) Grant of this application will further the public interest by promoting competition in international markets.

(g) The subject application is economically justified in that the revenues which CSI expects to derive from the proposed services for which authority is sought will exceed the expenses which CSI expects to incur in connection therewith. During the first year of operation, CSI projects that its revenues will exceed its costs in providing the international resale services for which authorization is hereby requested by approximately \$500,000.00.

(h) Service similar to that herein proposed is currently being offered by AT&T, MCI Telecommunications, Inc., US Sprint Communications Company, and other carriers with tariffs on file with the Commission. Existing facilities are inadequate to the extent that the entry of additional, resale carriers like CSI will promote more efficient service at lower prices and will stimulate increased demand.

(i) Upon grant of the instant application, CSI will file with the Commission, its F.C.C. Tariff No. 1 governing International Telecommunications Services, pursuant to Section 203 of the Communications Act, as amended 47 U.S.C. Section 203, and Part 61 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Part 61.

(j) Applicant will follow generally accepted accounting principles and will adhere to all applicable regulations of the Commission in connection with the services proposed hereunder.

(k) The authorization sought hereunder will not involve any construction of new facilities. Thus, authorization of the facilities hereby requested is categorically excluded under Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1306.

(l) CSI is not affiliated with any foreign carrier in any of the countries to which it proposes to provide service.

All are U.S. Citizens. Applicant has no affiliation with any U.S. facilities based carrier whose services it plans to resell.

(d) CSI does not now have any authority under Section 214 of the Act.

(e) (1) CSI is requesting authority to operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1). The authority requested is to acquire interests in all appropriately licensed U.S. common carrier and non-common carrier facilities, and any necessary overseas connecting facilities as needed, to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points, except to those points indicated on the Commission's exclusion list.

(e) (2) CSI is also requesting authority to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2).

(e) (3) CSI is not applying for authority to resell private lines for the purpose of providing international basic switched services to countries not on the FCC's published list of equivalent countries.

(h) (1) CSI has no affiliation with any foreign carrier.

(h) (2) CSI's ten percent or greater shareholders are:


(j) No party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
