

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**APPLICATION FOR STREAMLINED
INTERNATIONAL SECTION 214 AUTHORITY**

Copper Valley Long Distance, Inc. ("Copper Valley" or "Applicant") requests authorization, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, to resell the switched services of other common carriers to provide international switched telecommunications services between the United States and international points. See 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1988); International Section 214 Streamlining Order, 61 Fed. Reg. 15,724, 15,729 (1995) (codified at 47 C.F.R. § 63.18).

Copper Valley requests authorization to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e) (2) of the Rules. Unless formally opposed, the present application qualifies for streamlined treatment under Section 63.12 of the Rules. See International Section 214 Streamlining Order, supra at 15,728 (codified at 47 C.F.R. § 63.12).

Copper Valley's proposed resale of telephone service will

augment international telecommunications competition and, consequently, the public interest will be enhanced. Copper Valley's proposed offering will permit it to purchase telecommunications services at high-volume discounts and resell the services to its customers with efficient incorporation of its savings. The public interest will be served through Copper Valley's offering of rates which will be competitive with other similarly situated telecommunications carriers.

Grant of this application will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity and in support thereof, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules:

- d) Copper Valley has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 214. With the grant of this application, Copper Valley will have international resale authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act.
- e) Copper Valley is requesting authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e) (2) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e) (2).

C E R T I F I C A T I O N S

Affiliations

Copper Valley certifies that it is not a foreign carrier, and that it does not have an affiliation with any foreign carrier.

Copper Valley certifies that it does not have an affiliation with any of the U.S. carriers whose facilities-based international services it proposes to resell.

Ownership Of Applicant

The name, address, citizenship and principal business of the only entity having a ten percent (10%) or greater interest in the Applicant is as follows:

CVTTC is a local telephone cooperative whose ownership is shared in common by its subscribers. No individual person or entity holds a ten percent (10%) or greater interest in CVTTC.

While Copper Valley and CVTTC have separate boards of directors, two members of Copper Valley's board of directors also sit upon the board of CVTTC. Marvin Harned holds one of these joint positions on the Copper Valley and CVTTC boards. The other joint board position is currently vacant.

Due to the shortage of qualified management personnel in non-urban areas of Alaska, certain officers are also shared in common between Copper Valley and CVTTC. Tim Rennie serves as President of Copper Valley and as General Manager of CVTTC. In addition, Pamela Murphy serves as the Finance/Data Processing Manager both of Copper Valley and CVTTC.

Copper Valley: (1) will maintain separate books of account from CVTC; (2) will not jointly own transmission or switching facilities with CVTC; and (3) will take any tariffed services from CVTC pursuant to the terms and conditions of CVTC's generally applicable tariff.

Copper Valley will be treated as a nonregulated affiliate of its affiliated local exchange carrier for purposes of local exchange carrier accounting under the Commission's joint cost and affiliate transactions rules as set forth in Parts 32 and 64 of the Commission's Rules.

Foreign Concessions and Arrangements

Copper Valley hereby certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or foreign administration with respect to traffic and revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which the Applicant may serve under the authority sought; and that it will not enter into such agreements in the future.

Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification

Copper Valley certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, no party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.

CONCLUSION

In light of the foregoing, Copper Valley respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be served by a grant of the Section 214 authorization sought, and that such authorization should be issued to it for purposes of reselling the switched services of other common carriers to provide international switched telecommunications services between the United States and international points.
