Hi JoAnn -

I just spoke with Susan O'Connell and she suggested that I contact you about an issue I had with the Section 214 database. (Apparently, she has run into the same issue.)

One of our clients, Centennial Communications, has the following Section 214 authorization:

File No. **ITC-214-19980918-00669**
 Original Applicant: **Lambda Operations Corp.**

A notice of *Pro Forma* Assignment was filed on April 26, 2000, notifying that Lambda Operations Corp. had merged with Centennial Wireless PCS Operations Corp, which then changed its name to **Centennial Puerto Rico Operations Corp.** The *pro forma* assignment was placed on Public Notice on May 4, 2000.

However, when you do a search for authorizations held by Centennial, this authorization does not come up. (It does come up under Lambda.) Under the record, Lambda is listed as the "Applicant" but the Action Taken PN Date shows the 5/4/2000 PN for the *pro forma* assignment. I was wondering if there was any way this could be corrected in the FCC database.

I hope this makes sense. If not, feel free to give me a call.
