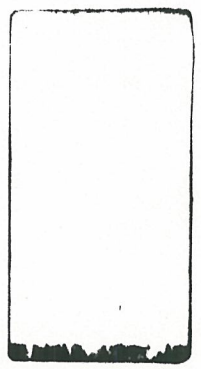

d) In 1982, Applicant was granted domestic Section 214 authority to operate as a resale common carrier and to resell communication services and/or facilities of other common carriers, on an interstate basis, throughout the contiguous United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the U.S., Virgin Islands. See File No. W-P-C-4326 (1982). Also in 1982, Applicant was granted domestic Section 214 authority to provide resale common carrier service by leasing dedicated communication facilities and by reselling metered use services between various locations throughout the continental United States. See File No. W-P-C-4787 (1982).

e) Applicant seeks authorization to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points, and to resell private lines for the purpose of providing international basic switched services to countries found to offer equivalent resale opportunities.

h) Applicant hereby certifies that it has no affiliation with any foreign carrier or U.S. carrier whose facilities-based services the Applicant proposes to resell.

Applicant is a wholly-owned subsidiary of North Pittsburgh Systems, Inc. ("NPSI"). NPSI, in turn, owns North Pittsburgh Telephone Company, Inc. No direct or indirect ownership of NPSI approaches 10%. 
