**Application**

Interlink Communications, Inc. (“Applicant”), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 63.18 of the Commission’s rules and regulations, hereby applies for such authority as may be required to operate as a facilities-based carrier to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points permitted to be served by the Commission and also to resell the international services of authorized United States common carriers, including international private lines interconnected with the public switched network to the extent permitted by the Commission’s rules, for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points.

Pursuant to Section 63.18 Applicant submits the following information in support of this application:
