APPLICATION

Infonet Broadband Services Corporation ("IBSC"), hereby requests authority,  
pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C.  
§ 214, and section 63.18 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, to provide global  
facilities-based services originating from all points in the United States and terminating at all  
international points, except within countries listed on the Commission's exclusion list.

IBSC is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. IBSC  
intends to obtain licensed United States common carrier and non-common carrier facilities, not  
appearing on the Commission's exclusion list, to provide its international switched and private  
line services, which will be tariffed where required by law and Commission rules. Grant of the  
instant application will provide additional service options for consumers and will enhance

competition in the market for international communications. For these reasons and those set forth below, IBSC respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity will be served by grant of the requested authority.


