Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, Cel-Net, Inc. ("Cel-Net"), hereby requests authority to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

Cel-Net is a corporation formed for the primary purpose of establishing a telecommunications business. Applicant has no foreign affiliations. Applicant serves business and residential customers throughout the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity by promoting competition in the international services marketplace.
