

APPLICATION

AIRTIME Technologies, Inc. (AIRTIME), a Florida corporation, hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international telecommunications resale service between the United States and international points.

AIRTIME is a U.S. company organized to provide telecommunications services. AIRTIME has no foreign affiliations. AIRTIME intends to serve customers throughout the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to AIRTIME.


