Application:

Onion Communication USA, Inc. ("Onion"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services in the United States and between the United States and international points.

Onion is a newly formed U.S. corporation, formed under the laws of the state of New York and organized to provide domestic and international telecommunication services. Onion has no foreign or domestic affiliations who provide any telecommunication services, but Onion is owned by Onion Communication BVI, Ltd., a British Virgin Islands corporation that is not in the telecommunications business. Onion intends to serve business customers throughout the United States, but has no current business.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the domestic and international telecommunication services market. Competition will benefit U.S. resellers and consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Onion.


