- 3) Any tariff services that resale applicant purchases from parent company will be purchased out of parent company's General Services Tariff.
- 4) The parent company will treat the resale applicant as a non-regulated affiliate for accounting purposes.
- 5) The parent company has one stockholder, Betty Humpert, who owns 50% of Community Telephone Company's Inc. stock. The parent company does not have any other stockholders who own 10% or more of the stock. Applicant's parent, Community Telephone Company, Inc, owns 100% of Applicant's stock.
