**APPLICATION FOR SECTION 214 AUTHORITY**

International Communications Enterprises Limited ("ICE"), by its attorneys, hereby submits this application for Section 214 Authority to operate as both a global facilities-based and global resale carrier to all authorized international points. This application is submitted pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18. As is explained below, ICE requests streamlined processing of this application.

ICE is a corporation organized under the laws of the United Kingdom. ICE is not currently licensed as a carrier in any other jurisdictions.

ICE seeks authority to provide service between the United States and all authorized international points. As is described in greater detail below, ICE does not have affiliations with carriers in any of the destination markets which it would serve pursuant to the requested authorization.
