Interactive Communication Systems, Inc. ("ICS") hereby requests authority, pursuant to
Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and
Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide international
facilities-based and resale services on a global basis.

provide domestic and international telecommunications services. ICS has no foreign affiliations.
