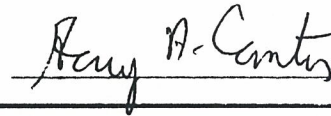

Application

Seven Seas Communications, Inc. ("Seven Seas") hereby requests global authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, for authority to provide facilities-based international communications services.

The provision of international service by Seven Seas will provide for additional competition in the international telecommunications market. Additional competition in the market benefits consumers of international telecommunications services by lowering prices and increasing availability of a variety of service options. Seven Seas submits, therefore, that grant of this application will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity and requests

that it be processed pursuant to the streamlined procedures applicable to non-dominant carriers. See 47 C.F.R. § 63.12.

Pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission's rules, Seven Seas submits the following information in support of the instant application:

- (d) The Applicant has been granted authority to resell Innmarsat Standard A service in the East and West Atlantic Ocean Regions ("AOR"), Pacific Ocean Region ("POR"), and Indian Ocean Region ("IOR") via the facilities of IDB Communications, Inc. See Seven Seas Communications, Inc., ITC-92-039 (rel. Apr. 10, 1992). Applicant also has been granted authority to provide Innmarsat Standard B and Standard M service in the AOR, POR, and IOR. See Seven Seas Communications, Inc., ITC-94-113 (rel. Apr. 8, 1994). Finally, Applicant has been granted authority to resell international public switched services. See Seven Seas Communications, Inc., ITC-95-509 (rel. Oct. 26, 1995).

- (e) Seven Seas is requesting global Section 214 authority under Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission's rules to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television, and business services to all international points, except those on the FCC's exclusion list, using licensed U.S. facilities and necessary overseas connecting facilities. As discussed below, Seven Seas is presumptively nondominant on all routes.
- (f) This application is subject to streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules.
- (g) This application does not involve any new construction and, therefore, it is categorically excluded from environmental processing pursuant to Section 1.1306 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1306.
- (h) Seven Seas certifies that it is not, and has no affiliation with, a foreign carrier as that term is defined in Section 63.18(h) of the Commission's rules. Accordingly, Applicant's proposed services are presumptively nondominant.

In support of the certification in this paragraph h, complete information concerning the name, address, citizenship, and principal business of Applicant's ten percent or greater shareholders is set forth in Exhibit 1. Seven Seas has no interlocking directorates.
- (i) Seven Seas certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country that Seven Seas may serve under the authority requested herein and that it will not enter into such agreements in the future.
- (j) Seven Seas certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.

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Accordingly, and for the reasons stated above, Seven Seas submits that it is qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority herein, and that the public interest would be served by grant of this application.
