

APPLICATION

Octet Communications Corporation ("Applicant"), hereby applies for authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, for authority to provide global international facilities-based and resale services of other carriers between the United States and various international points.

This application is qualified for streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules. Accordingly, Applicant respectfully requests streamlined processing of this routine application pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules.

PREAMBLE

Applicant is a competitive provider of telecommunications, internet, and information services. As part of its offering to subscribers, Applicant seeks to provide international long distance service and resell the international telecommunications services of other carriers. Granting Applicant's application will serve the public interest by providing residential and business consumers greater choice in telecommunications providers. Applicant's entrance into the telecommunications marketplace will foster competition and thus promote the public interest goals adopted by Congress in the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

(d) Applicant has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act, as amended.

(e) Applicant seeks Section 214 authority to operate as a global international facilities-based and a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(1) and 63.18 (e)(2) of the Commission's Rules respectively. Specifically, Applicant requests authority to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to international points, and resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points. Applicant further states that it will comply with all terms and conditions set forth in Section 63.18(e)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules.

(f) Not applicable. Applicant's proposal conforms to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2), and is subject to streamlined processing pursuant to Section 63.12 of the Commission's rules.

(g) Not applicable. Applicant does not seek facilities-based authority under paragraph (e)(6).

(h) (1) Applicant certifies that it is not, and is not affiliated with, a foreign carrier.


