

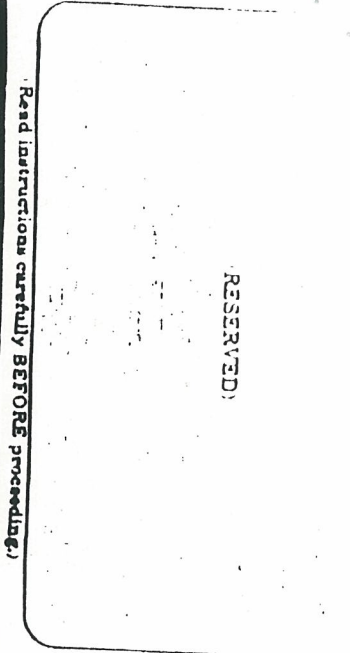

APPLICATION

Preferred Communications, Inc. ("PCI"), pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18(e)(2), hereby requests authority to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points.

By this application, PCI seeks to resell switched and private line service of authorized U.S. common carriers to its subscribers in compliance with the terms and conditions in Section 63.18(e)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules. PCI may also provide these international services to customers of other networks, under appropriate contractual arrangements.

In order to provide the above-described international services, PCI proposes to resell the services of facilities-based carriers currently authorized to provide the above-

described international services between the United States and international points. PCI would compete with other carriers that are already authorized to provide these international services to overseas points, creating additional competition in the market that will benefit consumers of international telecommunications service by lowering prices and increasing the availability of a wider variety of service options. Thus, the grant of this application is in the public interest.

In compliance with Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, PCI submits the following information in support of its application:

- (d) PCI has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.
- (e) PCI is requesting Section 214 authority to operate as a resale carrier

pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2). The authorization sought in this application will be used to resell the services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to international points.

(g) Because PCI is not seeking authority under Section 63.18(e)(6), this section is not applicable.

(h) PCI certifies pursuant to Section 63.18(h)(1) of the Commission's Rules that it does not have an affiliation with a foreign carrier as defined in Section 63.18(h)(1)(i) of the Commission's Rules.

As required by Section 63.18(h)(2) of Commission's Rules, PCI has attached a list of the names, addresses, citizenships and principal businesses of all PCI shareholders with 10 percent or greater direct or indirect interest in PCI. See Exhibit A. PCI's directors and officers do not serve on the boards of any affiliated or unaffiliated common carriers.

As required by Section 63.18(h)(3) of the Commission's Rules, PCI hereby certifies that it does not have an affiliation as defined in Section 63.18(h)(3) with any U.S. carrier whose facilities-based services PCI proposes to resell.

(i) PCI hereby certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which PCI may serve under the authority granted under this part and will not enter into such agreements in the future.


(j) PCI certifies pursuant to Sections 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Commission's Rules that neither the applicant nor any party to the application is subject

to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.

The instant application is being submitted under the procedures set forth in Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules. Specifically, since PCI (1) has no affiliation within the meaning of Section 63.18(h)(1)(i) of the Commission's Rules with a facilities-based foreign carrier in a destination market (Section 63.12(c)(1)), (2) has no affiliation within the meaning of Section 63.18(h)(1)(i) of the Commission's Rules with a dominant U.S. facilities-based carrier whose international switched services PCI seeks authority to resell (Section 63.12(c)(2)), and (3) does not seek authority to resell private line services to a country for which the Commission has not determined that equivalent resale opportunities exist between the United States and the destination country (Section 63.12(c)(3)), PCI will commence operations on the 36th day after the date of public notice listing the instant application as accepted for filing, unless the application is formally opposed or the Commission informs PCI in writing within 28 days of the public notice that this application is not eligible for streamlined processing under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules.

As demonstrated in the application, PCI is qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. PCI respectfully submits that for the reasons stated herein, grant of the authority requested will promote the public interest, convenience and necessity.
