**APPLICATION**

WJG MarITEL Corporation ("MarITEL") hereby requests authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to provide a full range of international telecommunications services as a reseller pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2).

This application requests "global" resale authority to provide service to all foreign destinations by means of any and all authorized international services and facilities of other carriers, apart only from provision of service to destinations and via international facilities included on the Commission's traditional "exclusion list." MarITEL also requests authority to resell international private lines to provide switched services between the United States and countries which the Commission has determined offer "equivalent resale opportunities" to U.S. carriers, including authority to resell private lines to any countries that the Commission may subsequently determine offer such equivalent resale opportunities. This application is submitted under the "streamlined" processing procedures provided for in Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules.

- (b) MarITEL is a business corporation organized under the laws of the State of Tennessee.

(d) MarITEL believes that it has received Section 214 authority in the past. MarITEL has provided marine communications service since 1936 and it was previously regulated by the FCC as a dominant carrier. MarITEL received FCC permission under Section 214 to discontinue service to particular service areas on a number of occasions. Unfortunately, the FCC's records do not permit MarITEL to determine the scope of authorization it may have possessed in the past. Accordingly, in an abundance of caution, MarITEL submits this application.

(e) MarITEL is requesting "global" Section 214 authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2).

(g) Not applicable.

(h)(1) MarITEL certifies that it has no affiliation with any foreign carrier as defined under Section 63.18(h)(1) of the Commission's Rules.

(h)(2) MCT Investors, LP ("MCT") 1555 King Street, Suite 500, Alexandria, VA. 22314, holds approximately 70% of the outstanding stock of MarITEL. MCT invests in communications and healthcare companies. The sole general partner of MCT is MedCom Development Corporation (controlled by Donald R. DePriest, see below).

Donald R. DePriest is the Chairman of the Board, President and sole shareholder of MedCom Development Corporation, the sole general partner of MCT. Mr. DePriest owns directly approximately 10% of the outstanding stock of the applicant. Mr. DePriest is a US citizen and uses the same mailing address as MCT. DePriest is an entrepreneur who invests in both telecommunications and healthcare companies.

Interlocking Directorates: None

(h)(3) MarITEL further certifies that it has no affiliation with any U.S. carrier whose facilities-based services MarITEL proposes to resell (either directly or indirectly through the resale of another reseller's service).


(i) MarITEL certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which MarITEL may serve under the authority granted under Part 63 of the Commission's Rules and will not enter into such agreements in the future.

(j) MarITEL certifies pursuant to §§ 1.2001 through 1.2003 of the Commission's Rules that no party to this application is subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1998. (See Exhibit C hereto).

The public interest will be served by grant of this application because it will promote competition in the provision of international telecommunications services, with the attendant benefits to consumers in the form of more choices and lower prices. This application is eligible for "streamlined" processing procedures since MarITEL: (i) is not affiliated with any foreign carrier or with any U.S. carrier whose international services it proposes to resell; and (ii) is filing only for such authority as permitted under the terms and conditions of Sections 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules. Accordingly, MarITEL requests the Commission to approve this application on a streamlined basis and to classify it as a non-dominant carrier.


