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APPLICATION OF SKYCOMM TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended

(47 U.S.C. § 214), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 63.18),
SkyComm Technologies, Inc. ("SkyComm" or "Applicant") hereby applies for authority
to provide facilities-based international switched voice, data, and business
telecommunications services of unaffiliated carriers from the United States to all
international points. This application is subject to streamlined processing under Section
63.12 of the Commission's rules.

Grant of the instant application would authorize SkyComm to provide
international facilities-based service, including but not limited to service over
INTELSAT satellites, U.S. separate system satellites and licensed U.S. earth stations. In
particular, the authorization will facilitate the provision of service through SkyComm's
earth station facility to be constructed in Houston, Texas. SkyComm will obtain all
necessary authorizations to provide such service. The Commission has found that the

introduction of new entrants into the international telecommunications marketplace promotes competition in rates, charges and services provided by carriers and thus furthers the public interest.

SkyComm hereby submits the information required under Section 63.18 of the Commission's rules. The information set forth below is labeled according to the corresponding rule section to which it is responsive.

(a) The name of the applicant is SkyComm Technologies. Applicant's principal offices are located at 15100 Lee Road, Suite 104, Humble, Texas 77396-2078. Applicant's phone number is (281) 441-9765.

(b) SkyComm is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas.

(d) Existing Authorizations. SkyComm currently holds no Section 214 authorizations.

(e) (1)(i) Authority Requested. SkyComm is requesting Section 214 authority to operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of

Section 63.18(e)(1) of the Commission's rules. By grant of this application, SkyComm

understands that it will become a carrier subject to Section 214 of the Communications Act.

(ii) Pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(1)(ii), SkyComm shall comply with the following terms and conditions: SkyComm will provide services to all international points in countries for which it qualifies for non-dominant regulation as set forth in §63.10, except where it is affiliated with a foreign carrier in a destination market and the Commission has not determined that the foreign carrier lacks sufficient market power in the destination market to affect competition adversely in the U.S. market, SkyComm will not commence service on any such route until it receives specific authority to do so under Section 63.18(e)(6) of the rules. SkyComm will only provide service using half-circuits on appropriately licensed U.S. common and non-common carrier facilities provided that these facilities do not appear on an exclusion list published by the Commission and any necessary overseas connecting facilities. SkyComm will not use non-U.S. licensed facilities unless and until the Commission specifically approves their use and so indicates on the exclusion list, and only then for service to the countries indicated thereon. SkyComm may provide service to any country not included on an exclusion list published by the Commission and may provide international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services. SkyComm shall be subject to all Commission rules and regulations and any conditions stated in the Commission's public notice or order that serves as the applicant's Section 214 certificate.¹

(h) Ten Percent or Greater Direct or Indirect Shareholders in SkyComm and Interlocking Directorates. The name, address, citizenship and principal business of Applicant's ten percent or greater direct and indirect equity holders follow. There are no relevant interlocking directorates.

Direct and Indirect Ownership. 100% of the stock is owned by the following persons, all of whom are United States citizens: 33.33% (one-third) is currently held by Bill B. and Nelda V. McCrary, 2702 Rolling Glen Drive, Spring, TX 77373, who are engaged in the satellite and telecommunications business; and 66.67% (two thirds) is currently held by Joseph K. and Ann L. Baker, 30721 Berry Creek Drive, Georgetown, TX 78628, who are in the technology integration and ranching business.

Foreign Carrier Affiliations. SkyComm holds no foreign carrier affiliations.

Status as Nondominant Carrier. This information is provided pursuant to Section 63.18(h)(5) of the Commission's rules. SkyComm holds no foreign carrier affiliations. Thus, SkyComm is presumptively nondominant on all routes pursuant to Section 63.10(a)(1) of the Commission's rules.

(i) Special Concessions Certification. Pursuant to Section 63.18(i), SkyComm has not agreed to accept any special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or foreign administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which SkyComm may serve under the authority granted pursuant to this Application and will not enter into any such agreements in the future.

(j) Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification. Pursuant to Section 63.18G),

SkyComm certifies that, in accordance with 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.2001-1.2003, no officer, director or five percent or more equity holder has been denied Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.

(k) Streamlined Processing. For the reasons discussed above, SkyComm qualifies for a presumption of non-dominance under Section 63.10(a)(3) of the Commission's rules. This application is therefore subject to streamlined pursuant to Section 63.12(c)(1)(i) of the Commission's rules.

Accordingly, SkyComm respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity will be served by grant of the instant application.
