Application

Vocom International Telecommunications, Inc. ("Vocom"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities based and resale services between the United States and international points.

Vocom is a new United States company organized to provide international telecommunications services via the Internet through a proprietary technology call "Future Tel" which has been licensed to Vocom by Vocom Tech Company. After an end user calls an 800 telephone number, their voice will be digitized into packets and transmitted through the Internet backbone. Upon reaching the destination gateway, the packets will be reconstructed into voice format and passed out to the PSTN line. Vocom intends to market its Future Tel service to major telecommunications carriers, businesses and retail customers throughout the United States. Vocom has no foreign affiliations.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit United States customers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Vocom.
