**Application**

Eastern Telesis Inc. ("Eastern Telesis"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international telecommunications resale carrier services between United States and multiple international points.

Eastern Telesis is a new U.S. company organized to provide global international telecommunications resale services to all residential and business customers in the United States. Eastern Telesis has no foreign affiliations at this time. Eastern Telesis serves primarily international customers throughout the United States.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market.
