APPLICATION

NOW COMES, UNIVERSAL TELECOM LTD., INC. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Klein, Zelman, Rothermel & Dichter, L.L.P., pursuant to § 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18, makes this Application to the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") for global international resale service authority between the United States and international points. e. Applicant hereby requests Section 214 authority to operate as a global reseller of international telecommunications services pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's rules.

f. At this time, Applicant is not applying for any other authority set forth in paragraph (e) of Section 63.18.

g. Applicant is not seeking facilities-based authority under paragraph (e)(6) of Section 63.18.

h. Applicant hereby certifies that it is entirely a domestic corporation with no foreign affiliations.

CONCLUSION

Applicant believes that there is significant potential for continued growth in the international voice market and that this market expansion will be accelerated by additional competition by new entrants. This position is consistent with the Commission's findings that increased competition in international markets benefits the public interest. Applicant is legally, financially and technically qualified to provide the service for which it requests global resale authority. For the reasons stated above, Applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by granting Applicant's § 214 Application. The request for global resale authorization should, therefore, be issued to Applicant for the purpose of providing resold switched voice communications from the United States to international points.
