APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

Spata Communications Corporation ("Spata") hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and Section 63.01 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.01, to resell the international telecommunications services of other common carriers between the United States and various international points.

Spata is a privately-held corporation organized under the laws of the state of Delaware. The Company intends to resell the telecommunications facilities of other common carriers and is not a facilities-based carrier. Spata's service will be offered for use by residential and business customers who subscribe to the Company's interstate and/or intrastate services. Through its service, customers may originate calls from locations within the United States to other countries. The Company seeks authority to resell international telecommunications services to better serve its Customers by offering a full range of telecommunications products and services. By providing international calling services Spata will be able to offer its Customers valuable service at competitive rates.

International telecommunications services will be obtained by Spata from other common carriers who are currently authorized by the Commission to provide international service. Initially, Spata will only resell international switched services. However, Spata requests authority to resell private line service in the future as contemplated under Section 63.18 (e) (2) and subject to the restrictions imposed therein.

The provision of international service by Spata will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. However, additional competition in the market - including the competition of Spata - benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service options. Thus, the grant of this authorization is consistent with the public interest.

In support of Spata's request for authorization, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18.

- (d) Spata has not received previous authority under Section 214.
- (e) Spata requests Section 214 Authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2). Specifically, Spata proposes to resell the international services of any authorized common carrier pursuant to tariff or contract duly filed with the Commission, for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business service to all international points, as authorized by the Commission.
- (f) See (e) above.
- (g) Spata does not seek facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(6).
- (h) Spata certifies that it is not a foreign carrier nor is Spata affiliated with any foreign carrier. Applicant further certifies that it has no affiliation with any U.S. Carriers whose facilities-based services Spata proposes to resell. In support of this certification, Spata submits the following information of its ten percent or greater direct and indirect shareholders or other equity holders.

Peter Buonaiuto is the sole stockholder and is a citizen of the United States. Mr. Buonaiuto's primary business is Spata Communications Corporation

- (i) Spata certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which the applicant may serve and will not enter into such agreements in the future.
  
- (j) The Applicant certifies that neither Spata nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits, as provided in the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. 853a.



Conclusion

As demonstrated in this application, Spata Communications Corporation is legally, financially and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. For the reasons stated above, applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Section 214 application.
