APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY UNDER
SECTION 214 OF THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT

The City of Hawarden, Iowa d/b/a HITTEC Long Distance hereby requests, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act and Sections 63.18(e)(2) and 63.12 of the Commissioner's rules, authority to resell international message telephone service ("IMTS") between points in the United States to various international points by reselling the services of unaffiliated carriers. Because HITTEC Long Distance is not affiliated with a foreign carrier and is not affiliated with the U.S. facilities-based carriers whose international services it wishes to resell, HITTEC Long Distance' applications should properly qualify for streamlined treatment under Section 63.12 of the Commission's Rules unless formally opposed.

HITTEC Long Distance entry into the international market will promote competition and stimulate more efficient use of telecommunications resources. Moreover, HITTEC Long Distance is legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide the requested services. In support of HITTEC Long Distance' request for authorization, the following information is set forth pursuant to Section 63.18:

(d) Applicant is not presently subject to Section 214 of the Act, but will become subject to Section 214 as a result of its proposed international service resale operations.

(e) The applicant is requesting authority to resell the international services of authorized U.S. common carriers for the provisions of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business services to all international points. Thus, it is requesting authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2). Applicant, HITTEC Long Distance, is not currently operating as a facilities-based carrier.

Certifications

- (1) HITTEC Long Distance hereby certifies that it is not owned by or affiliated with a foreign carrier for purposes of Section 63.18(h) of the Commissioner's Rules.
- (2) In support of this certification HITTEC Long Distance provides the following stockholder information:
 - No shareholder has ten percent or greater ownership in HITTEC Long Distance.
 - There are no interlocking directorates.
 - HITTEC is a wholly owned subsidiary of the City of Hawarden, Iowa.
- (3) HITTEC Long Distance hereby certifies that it is not affiliated with the U.S. carriers whose facilities-based services it proposes to resell.
- (4) HITTEC Long Distance hereby certifies that no party to the application is subject to a denial of the Federal benefits requested herein pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 853(a).
- (5) HITTEC Long Distance hereby certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions directly or indirectly from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the U.S. and any foreign country which it may serve under the authority granted under this part and will not enter into such agreements in the future.

CONCLUSION

In light of the foregoing, HITTEC Long Distance respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be served by a grant of the Section 214 application sought, and that such authorization be issued to HITTEC Long Distance for

purposes of reselling IMTS between points in the United States and various international points.
