

Northwest Telephone, Inc. ("Northwest") hereby requests authority pursuant to §214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to resell transmission lines for the provision of common carrier services between the United States, its territories or possessions and foreign international points. In support of this application, Northwest provides the following:

Point of Contact Information

Northwest Telephone, Inc. ("Northwest") is a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Washington. Northwest has its principal place of business located at 1630 North Wenatchee Avenue, Suite 9, Wenatchee, WA 98801. The telephone and fax numbers for its principal place of business are, respectively, (509) 662-5671 and (509) 667-8421. The authorized representative for Northwest is Andrew Metcalfe, President of Northwest. Northwest's designated point of contact is its legal counsel, Jay N. Lazrus of the Myers Keller Communications Law Group. Mr. Lazrus' address is 1522 K Street, NW, Suite 1100, Washington, DC 20005. Mr. Lazrus can be reached at (202) 371-0062.

Previous Authority

Applicant Northwest has not previously received authority under §214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to resell transmission lines for the provision of common carrier communications services between the United States, its territories or possessions, and foreign international points.

Request under 47 C.F.R. §63.18(e)(2)

Applicant Northwest is requesting §214 authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of 47 C.F.R. §63.18(e)(2).

Northwest intends to resell common carrier services initially in the state of Washington. Northwest has a number of potential clients, including small business and individuals who will rely on Northwest for essential telecommunications services.

A grant of the requested application for authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of §63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules would facilitate Northwest's ability to deliver vital telecommunications services to the public, including, but not limited to, those potential small business enterprises and individuals who will rely heavily on Northwest for essential telecommunications services.

Northwest is an entity qualified to offer long distance service both in terms of personnel and resources. A grant of this §214 application would facilitate Northwest's ability to serve the

public by providing a more complete set of services to customers. Further, grant of this §214 application would serve the public convenience by allowing customers, if they so choose, to “one stop shop” for their long distance service. In order to effectively compete with other long distance service providers, Northwest must offer international long distance service as well as domestic long distance telecommunications services. Increased competition is a fundamental goal of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. A denial of the requested application will hamper Northwest’s ability to provide competitive services and will stifle competition in Northwest’s markets. Therefore, grant of the requested application is clearly in the public interest, convenience and necessity.

#### Certifications

Northwest, pursuant to §63.18(h)(1) of the Commission’s Rules hereby certifies that it does not have an affiliation with a foreign carrier. In support of the foregoing certification, pursuant to §63.18(h)(2) of the Commission’s Rules, ~~Exhibit 1~~ contains the names, addresses, citizenship and principal businesses of Northwest’s ten percent or greater direct equity holders. There are no parties that are indirectly able to exercise control over ten percent or more of Northwest’s equity. In addition, there are no interlocking directorates.

Northwest, pursuant to §63.18(h)(3) of the Commission’s Rules, hereby certifies that it does not have an affiliation, directly or indirectly, with any United States carrier whose facilities-based service(s) Northwest proposes to resell or with any foreign telephone carrier.

Northwest, pursuant to §63.18(D) of the Commission's Rules, hereby also certifies that it has not agreed to accept special concessions, directly or indirectly, from any foreign carrier or administration with respect to traffic or revenue flows between the United States and any foreign country which Northwest may serve under the authority granted and will not enter into such agreements in the future.

Northwest, pursuant to §63.18(j) of the Commission's Rules, hereby further certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Therefore, for the good cause shown above, Northwest hereby requests that the Commission grant the foregoing application.
