(d) Applicant does not presently have any authority under Section 214 of the Communications Act. Upon grant of this application, Net Communications will become an authorized non-dominant reseller with global authority, subject to

Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and the Commission's Rules. Net Communications lacks the market power that would allow it to control prices to the detriment of market competition.

- (e) Net Communications hereby requests four types of authority, all of which are eligible for streamlined processing. Specifically, Net Communications requests: (1) global facilities-based authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(1) of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(1), to acquire interests in U.S. authorized facilities as well as necessary connecting facilities to provide international telecommunications services between the United States and all international points except those countries excluded by the Exclusion List; (2) global authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(2), to resell the international switched services of all United States-authorized carriers, other than those affiliated carriers with market power on a particular route, to provide international switched services between the United States and all international points served by those carriers; (3) global authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(2), to resell international private lines to provide international non-interconnected private line services between the United States and all international points; and (4) authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(e)(2), to resell international private lines interconnected to the public switched network ("PSN") at one or both ends to provide international switched services on all international routes on which the Commission permits such services to be provided.
- (f) Applicant seeks authority to provide only services referenced under paragraph (e) of Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules.
- (g) The authority requested in this application is categorically excluded from environmental processing as defined by Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1306. As such, an environmental assessment is not required for purposes of this application and is therefore not attached.
- (h) Net Communications certifies that it is not affiliated with any United States or foreign carriers whose facilities-based services it proposes to resell. Net Communications is affiliated within the meaning of Section 63.18(h)(1) of the Commission's Rules with Telexpress S.A. de C.V. ("Telexpress") and Versatel Telecomunicaciones, S.A. ("Versatel"), corporations authorized to provide international telecommunications services in Mexico and Guatemala respectively. Telexpress and Versatel are recent entrants to the Mexican and Guatemalan markets and, as such, do not possess the ability to discriminate against unaffiliated carriers to the detriment of competition. As a result, Applicant's affiliation with those companies poses no threat to competition.


CONCLUSION
