**APPLICATION FOR SECTION 214 AUTHORITY TO OPERATE AS
AN INTERNATIONAL FACILITIES-BASED AND RESALE CARRIER**

PREAMBLE

MSTel International, LLC ("MSTel"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.

MSTel is a new U.S. company organized to provide international telecommunications services. MSTel has no foreign affiliations. MSTel is seeking authority to provide international IP telephone service between the United States and various international locations.

By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to MSTel.
