Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18, Icom Holding, Inc. d/b/a Icom Communication ("ICOM"), hereby requests authority to provide global international facilities-based and resale services between the United States and international points.
