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**Application**

NuTel Corporation ("NuTel") hereby applies for authority pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as Amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982) and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.18, to provide international facilities-based services and international switched resale services between the United States and international points.

NuTel requests authorities by this Application, all of which are eligible for streamlined processing. A grant of this Application will further the Commission's pro-competitive policies and serve the public interest by offering the benefits of increased customer choice, lower prices, and alternative services by new entrants to the international marketplace.

**Section 63.18 Information**

The following information is set forth in response to the corresponding relevant provisions of Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules:

(a) The applicant is NuTel Corporation with its principal place of business located at 14860 NE N. Woodinville Way, Woodinville, WA 98072.

(b) NuTel is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Washington.

(d) NuTel has not previously received authority under Section 214 of the Act.

(e) (1) NuTel requests authority to operate as a facilities-based carrier pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(1) and to acquire ownership interests in unaffiliated, U.S. licensed facilities, and any necessary overseas connecting facilities as needed, to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television, and business telecommunications services between the United States and all international points, except to those points indicated on the Commission's Exclusion List.

(2) NuTel also requests global authority pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) to resell international, switched services of all authorized carriers to provide international basic switched, private line, data, television, and business services between the United States and all international points served by

those carriers, other than those requiring special authority because of their listing on the Commission's Exclusion List.

(f) At this time, NuTel seeks no other authorization available under Section 63.18(e).

(g) No applicable.

(h) NuTel certifies that it is not affiliated with any foreign carrier as that term is defined by the Part 63 of the Commission's Rules or with any dominant U.S. facilities-based carriers.
