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APPLICATION AND REQUEST FOR AUTHORITY

Mutual provides individual health and accident insurance coverage, including major medical and hospital, dental, disability, Medicare supplement, long-term care and cancer coverage. By granting this Application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity by promoting competition in the international services market. Competition will benefit U.S. consumers by increasing service options and lowering prices. Thus, the public interest will be served by the grant of Section 214 authority to Mutual.
