APPLICATION

Infonet Broadband Services Corporation ("IBSC"), hereby requests authority,
pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C.
§ 214, and Section 63.18 of the Commission's rules, to resell international services of authorized
U.S. common carriers originating from all points in the United States and terminating at all
international points, except within countries listed on the Commission's exclusion list.

IBSC is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. IBSC
intends to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to Section 63.18(e)(2) of the Commission's rules.
Grant of the instant application will provide additional service options for consumers and will
enhance competition in the market for international communications. For these reasons and as
set forth below, IBSC respectfully submits that the public interest, convenience, and necessity
will be served by grant of the requested authority.
