Nustar Communications, Inc. is new a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Georgia.

The company intends to resell the telecommunications facilities of other common carriers and is not a facilities-based carrier. Nustar Communications, Inc. services will be offered nationwide. Through it's service, customers may originate calls nationwide or in other countries for termination in the United States or to other countries. The company seeks authority to resell international telecommunication services to better serve its customers by offering a full range of telecommunications products and services. By providing international calling services, Nustar Communications, Inc. will be able to offer its customers a valuable service at competitive rates.

International telecommunications services will be obtained by Nustar Communications, Inc. from other currently authorized common carriers. Nustar Communications, Inc. will resell the services of other facilities-based carriers that have obtained authorization from this commission including those listed in paragraph (E).

The provision of International service by Nustar Communications, Inc. will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. By granting this application, the Commission will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity. Customers of Nustar Communications, Inc. will have greater access to a variety of services and the international services market will benefit from increased competition. Ultimately, consumers of telecommunications services will benefit from increased price competition and the availability of a wide service selection. Thus, the grant of Section 214 authority to Nustar Communications, Inc. is consistent with the public interest.

As demonstrated in this application, Nustar Communications, Inc. is legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. For the reasons stated above, applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Section 214 application.

(E) Nustar Communications, Inc. request global international resale Section 214 authority pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18 (e) (2) of the Commission's Rules. The authorization sought in this application will be used so that international points may be reached by customers of Nustar Communications, Inc. resold services. Multi-Fox, Inc. proposes to offer switched telecommunications services to its customers. 


