APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY

Cincinnati Bell Wireless, LLC ("CBW"), hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214 (1982), and Section 63.18 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18(e)(2), to provide global international telecommunications resale carrier services between the United States and multiple international points.

CBW is U.S. company which provides Personal Communications Services ("PCS") to customers throughout the Cincinnati and Dayton-Springfield BTA regions of the United States. CBW has no foreign affiliations at this time.

CBW's provision of international service will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. Additional competition in the market - including the competition CBW will provide - benefits consumers of international telecommunications services.

The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service

options. CBW submits therefore, that grant of this application will serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity
