**APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY**

Hotel Connect Management, Inc. ("Hotel Connect") hereby requests authority, pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. Section 214, and Section 63.01 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.01, to resell the international telecommunications services of other common carriers between the United States and various international points.

Hotel Connect is a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Nevada. The Company intends to resell the telecommunications services of other common carriers and is not a facilities-based carrier. Hotel Connect's service will be offered for use by residential consumers, business customers with foreign offices, foreign firms with US operations, or other individuals and entities who subscribe to the Company's interstate and/or intrastate services. Through Hotel Connect's service, customers may originate calls from locations within the United States to other countries, and from foreign locations to terminate in the United States. The Company seeks authority to resell international telecommunications services to better serve its customers by offering a full range of call termination options. By providing international calling services Hotel Connect will be able to offer its customers valuable service at competitive rates.

International telecommunications services will be obtained by Hotel Connect from other common carriers who are currently authorized by the Commission to provide international service. Initially, Hotel Connect will only resell international switched services. However, Hotel Connect requests authority to resell private line service in the future as contemplated under Section 63.18 (e) (2) and subject to the restrictions imposed therein.

The provision of international service by Hotel Connect will not have any significant impact on the general provision of such service to the public. However, additional competition in the market - including the competition of Hotel Connect - benefits consumers of international telecommunications services. The benefits of competition include lower prices and increased availability of a variety of service options. Thus, the grant of this authorization is consistent with the public interest.

In support of Hotel Connect's request for authorization, the following information is submitted pursuant to Section 63.18 of the Commission Rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 63.18.

- (d) Hotel Connect has not received previous authority under Section 214.
- (e) Hotel Connect requests Section 214 Authority to operate as a resale carrier pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 63.18(e)(2). Specifically, Hotel Connect proposes to resell the international services of any authorized common carrier pursuant to tariff or contract duly filed with the Commission, for the provision of international basic switched, private line, data, television and business service to all international points, as authorized by the Commission.
- (f) See (e) above.
- (g) Hotel Connect does not seek facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(6).



(h) Hotel Connect certifies that it is not a foreign carrier nor is Hotel Connect affiliated with any foreign carrier. Applicant further certifies that it has no affiliation with any U.S. Carriers whose facilities-based services Hotel Connect proposes to resell. In support of this certification, Hotel Connect submits the following information of its ten percent or greater direct and indirect shareholders or other equity holders.

(j) The Applicant certifies that neither Hotel Connect nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of Federal benefits, as provided in the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. 853a.



## Conclusion

As demonstrated in this application, Hotel Connect Management, Inc. is legally, financially and technically qualified to provide the services for which it requests authority. For the reasons stated above, applicant submits that the public interest, convenience and necessity would be furthered by a grant of this Section 214 application.
