APPLICATION FOR SECTION 214 CERTIFICATION

Specifically, this application requests authority to resell the international services of authorized United States common carriers for the provision of international public switched, private line, data, and other long distance telephone services to all international points.

(g) Applicant does not request facilities-based authority under Section 63.18(e)(6).
